Green networks for people and wildlife	No mention of cycling, walking or green space
Healthy sustainable food in Scotland's schools and hospitals	Again, despite a bill on free school meals and one on 'farming for the future' there is nothing about promoting local food in this manifesto.
Better protection and management of Scotland's nature	Solidarity has no specific policies on protection of nature.
